

Helpful Tips

For Encouraging the Positive

- 1. Acknowledging the effort is just as important as praising when the task or activity is complete
- 2. Provide feedback that is specific and not judgmental
- 3. Use the child's name when providing feedback or encouragement
- 4. Recognize the child's assets and strengths
- 5. Focus on the positive things children are doing to create a positive classroom climate
- 6. Give children opportunities to recognize the accomplishments of their peers and teachers
- 7. Celebrate successes no matter how small!
