Pull out a card during whole group time and have the children use the Problem Solving Boy or the Solution Kit to solve the problem.

	<p>Miss Karen got a new toy car for the children to use during free play time. Jacob saw the car and has wanted to play with it all day. When it's time for free time Jacob goes to the shelf and gets the car, but the first time he rolls it down the carpet Dara accidentally steps on it and the car breaks in half.</p> <p>Jacob is so sad he starts to cry.</p> <p><i>Use the Problem Solving Boy steps to help Jacob solve his problem</i></p>
